WASHINGTON, D.C. – November 12, 2025 – Today, the American Accountability Foundation (AAF) launched [Alaska Influence Pipeline](#), an investigative website revealing how national advocacy networks, dark-money foundations, and Outside activists are shaping Alaska’s future – often under the guise of local activism and without the consent or knowledge of Alaskans.

The site reveals how powerful national players are using Alaska as a testing ground for policy experiments conceived in Washington and Silicon Valley. From criminal-justice reform and climate mandates to minimum-wage campaigns, Arabella Advisors’ network of nonprofits is quietly exporting its agenda north. This network has driven millions of dollars through fiscal sponsors, ballot initiatives, and media operations designed to look like grassroots but rooted in D.C. strategy.

“These groups are coming after Alaska because they know it's a bastion of rugged independence and energy independence, and there's few things the left hates more,” said Tom Jones, President of the American Accountability Foundation. “These Outside groups think they can tell Alaskans how to manage the natural resources that have sustained families and communities for generations. The Alaska Influence Pipeline shines a light on the money, networks, and agendas reshaping the state’s future from the outside in.”

The site combines original research, interactive data, and verifiable documentation allowing Alaskans to see the facts for themselves.

The goal: to equip citizens, journalists, and policymakers with transparent, factual information so Alaska’s future remains accountable, informed, and driven by Alaskans – not Outside interests.
